


HEALTH PROFESSIONAL REGULATORY STRUCTURE IN BERMUDA



STATUTORY BOARDS:

- Set and maintain high standards of professional competence and conduct.
- Overseeing the regulation of specific health professions.

COUNCIL FOR ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONS (CAHP) **SUB-BOARDS:**


- Recommend requirements for professional registration.
- Set standards for continuing professional development (CPD).

THE COMPLAINTS/CONDUCT COMMITTEES:

- Investigate complaints involving professional misconduct.
- Refer matters for inquiry before the respective statutory boards as necessary.

REGISTRARS:

- Receive applications for registration.
- Maintain the official register of regulated health professionals.
- Act based on the direction provided by statutory boards.







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
