

# Bermuda's **Health Professional** Regulatory Structure

### **MINISTRY OF HEALTH:**

• Appoints members to both the statutory boards and the professional conduct/complaints committees.

#### **STATUTORY BOARDS:**

- Set and maintain high standards of professional competence
- Overseeing the regulation of specific health professions.

### COUNCIL FOR ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONS (CAHP) **SUB-BOARDS:**

- Recommend requirements for professional registration.
- Set standards for continuing professional development (CPD).

### THE COMPLAINTS/CONDUCT COMMITTEES:

- Investigate complaints involving professional misconduct.
- Refer matters for inquiry before the respective statutory boards as necessary.

### **REGISTRARS:**

- Receive applications for registration.
- Maintain the official register of regulated health professionals.
- Act based on the direction provided by statutory boards.

# Why Modernize?

- Strengthen public protection and trust.
- Harmonize standards and competencies.

- Align with international best regulatory practices.
- Promote quality and evidence-based practice
- Standardize registration processes
- Clarify roles and responsibilities



# Purpose of Health Professional Regulation

- Protect the Public
  - Ensure safe, competent, and ethical care
- Maintain Standards
  - Set clear expectations for practice and conduct
- **Support Accountability** 
  - Provide mechanisms for oversight and addressing concerns
- **Foster Public Trust** 
  - Strengthen confidence in health professionals and the system
- Enable Modernization
  - Adapt to evolving health needs, technologies, and workforce realities



# Stakeholder Engagement Working Together

- Health Council to lead initiative and provide statutory board oversight.
- Co-develop key aspects and work in close collaboration.
- Ensure inclusivity and transparency.
- Build shared understanding and ownership of the process.

## Phase 4: Public Consultation


Publish draft proposal for public consultation and feedback.
