

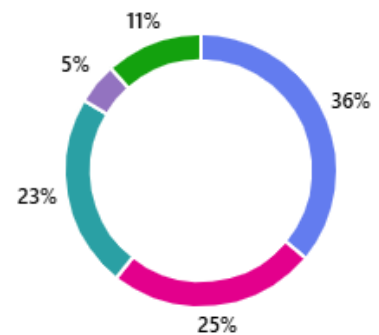
Survey Results - Consultation Priorities

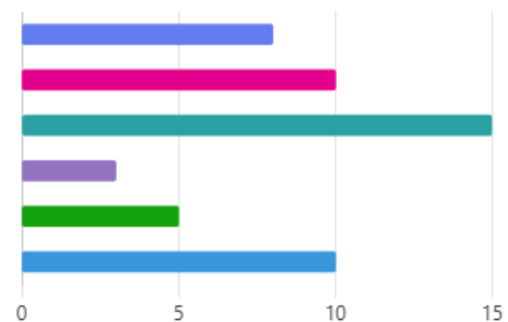
1) What consultation method(s) do you prefer?

Weekday- evening (in person)	10



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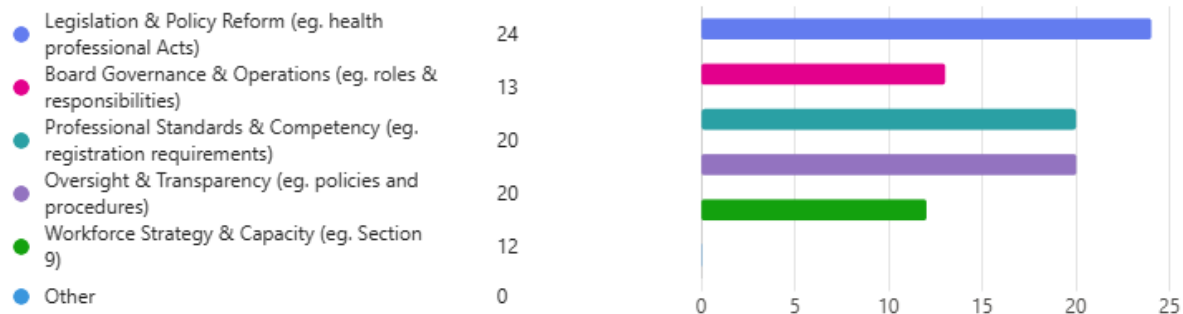


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3) What key topics are most important for you to discuss during the consultation process?
